TOSLMS STUDENT MANUAL



The TOSLMS Manual (4.1.16) for Students provides guidance on how to use TOS-LMS, a Learning Management System (LMS), from a student's perspective. Below is a structured overview of key features and functionalities:

1. Accessing TOSLMS -

- Login: Visit www.TOSLMS.org and enter your username and password.
- Dashboard: After logging in, you'll see your dashboard with enrolled courses, deadlines, and recent activity.
- Profile: Click on your name (top-right) to edit profile settings, including preferences and notifications.

2. Navigating a Course

- Course Layout: Courses may have a grid, list, or weekly format.
- Sections: Content is organized in sections (e.g., by week or topic).
- Completion Tracking: Some courses show checkmarks (✓) when you complete activities.

3. Course Activities & Resources

Common Activities:

- Assignments: Submit files or text directly to your instructor.
- Quizzes: Timed assessments with multiple-choice, short answer, or other question types.
- Forums: Participate in discussions with peers and instructors.
- Lessons: Interactive, branching content with questions.
- Workshops: Peer-assessment activities.

Common Resources:

- Files (PDFs, PPTs, etc.)
- URLs (links to external websites)
- Books (multi-page resources)

4. Submitting Assignments

- 1. Open the assignment and read the instructions.
- 2. Upload files or type directly into the text box.
- 3. Click Submit (or Save as Draft if allowed).
- 4. Check for a confirmation message.

5. Taking Quizzes

- Follow time limits and navigation rules.
- Some quizzes may allow multiple attempts.
- Review results if feedback is enabled.

6. Tracking Progress

- Grades: Check your grades via the Grades link in the course or navigation menu.
- Completion Tracking: Some courses show progress indicators (e.g., "Completed" badges).

7. Messaging & Notifications

- Messages: Communicate privately with instructors/peers via the messaging system.
- Notifications: Enable email or in-app alerts for deadlines, grades, and forum posts.

8. Mobile Access

- Use the Moodle App (iOS/Android) for on-the-go access.
- Features may vary slightly from the desktop version.

9. Troubleshooting

- Login Issues: Contact your TOSLMS's IT support.
- Missing Courses: Ask your instructor if enrollment is correct.
- Browser Problems: Try Chrome, Firefox, or Edge; clear cache if needed.
